

How to go to MCDHH page Request a Training

- 1. Type
 - https://www.mass.gov/orgs/massachusetts-commission-for-the-deaf-and-hard-of-hearing into your web browser and press the enter key.
- 2. Scroll down a little and highlight and click on I want to..



3. Click on Request a Training


 Next page will give you the training event information fill up the form with details and hit next to enter the logistical information.
